Dr. Frank J.M. Verstraete graduated as a veterinarian at the University of Gent (Belgium). He pursued his graduate studies at the University of Pretoria (South Africa) where he completed a residency in small animal surgery. Professor Verstraete is a Charter Diplomate of the European Veterinary Dental College, as well as a Diplomate of the American Veterinary Dental College and the European College of Veterinary Surgeons. He is affiliated with the University of California at Davis, where he is Professor of Dentistry and Oral Surgery, and Chief of the Dentistry & Oral Surgery Service. He is also an Adjunct Professor in the Department of Orofacial Sciences, Division of Oral Medicine, Oral Pathology and Oral Radiology, at the School of Dentistry of the University of California, San Francisco. His main research interests are comparative oral pathology, diagnostic imaging and surgery. His book “Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery in Dogs and Cats” was the first speciality book in veterinary dentistry.

Her main activities are Equine dentistry and sinus surgery, Colic and soft tissue surgery in horses, Teaching of students and Training of vets.
